

Reconstruction of New York City’s Gilboa Dam

The 83-year-old Gilboa Dam that impounds Schoharie Reservoir is a key component of the New York City Department of Environmental Protection’s (NYCDEP) water supply system. This water supply system serves approximately eight million people in New York City and one million people upstate, delivers approximately 1.2 billion gallons of water per day, and is arguably the largest gravity fed, unfiltered,

water supply system in the world. The Schoharie Reservoir accounts for approximately 15 percent of the water delivered by this system. In 2004, the NYCDEP embarked on a program to completely renovate and update Gilboa Dam. The NYCDEP, along with its Design Team, a joint-venture of **Gannett Fleming** and Hazen and Sawyer, has navigated through a maze of
